## Things You Can Do:

- Award tickets to kids as they check in for summer reading (requires working with a computer and the summer reading software). **We will need the majority of our volunteers to do this throughout the day!**
- Supervise the Discovery Day activities on Tuesdays from 11am-2pm - keep the area relatively clean and help kids as needed. One or two volunteers will be assigned to this area each week.

## Program Dates

Program begins: Saturday, June 1  
Program ends: Wednesday, August 21

Please pick a time and day that you would like to volunteer throughout the summer. For example: Mondays, 1-3pm. Also pick some back-up times that you are available, in case your first choice is already taken. **Remember:** We are only able to schedule one volunteer per time slot and each person will be permitted to volunteer a maximum of two 2-hour shifts per week in order to give more people an opportunity to participate in our summer volunteer program.
