

Join Schlow and our partners for a Bracken Lecture Series event and the culmination of the annual "one book, one community" read. The 2022 Centre County Reads selection is *Braiding*

Sweetgrass: Indigenous Wisdom, Scientific Knowledge and the Teachings of Plants by **Robin Wall Kimmerer**. Drawing on her life as an indigenous scientist, and as a woman, Kimmerer shows how other living beings offer us gifts and lessons, even if we've forgotten how to hear their voices. In reflections that range from the creation of Turtle Island to the forces that threaten its flourishing today, she circles toward a central argument: that the awakening of ecological consciousness requires the acknowledgment and celebration of our reciprocal relationship with the rest of the living world.

This Bracken Lecture Series event is a partnership between the Department of Landscape Architecture in Penn State's College of Arts and Architecture, the Arboretum at Penn State, the Penn State Sustainability Institute, and Centre County Reads.
